Citizenship in the Community Merit Badge

Local government, community service, and how scouts can be active, informed members of their community.

Typical time to complete: **4–8 weeks**

Tips for Earning This Badge

- 1 The civic visit requirement (attending a local government meeting) takes planning — school board meetings count and are often easier to attend than city council sessions.
- 2 Take notes during the meeting; you will reference them in your written summary.
- 3 The community service project can overlap with service hours you are already doing for rank advancement.
- 4 Start the interview with an elected official early — scheduling takes longer than scouts expect.
- 5 Counselors want specifics, not generalities — "the council discussed a road repaving budget" lands better than "they talked about town stuff."
- 6 A common pitfall: picking a meeting that gets cancelled or rescheduled with no backup date. Have a second meeting on your calendar before you need it.
