OVERVIEW

The Historian documents troop life — photos, scrapbooks, event logs, and memory books. They capture what the troop does so the story can be told at Courts of Honor and passed down to future scouts.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3 Maintain a troop scrapbook or digital archive
- 4 Prepare photo slideshows for Courts of Honor
- 5 Help create year-end troop recap materials
